Robert Burns was a Freemason. He was initiated on July 4, 1781, in St David's Lodge, No, 174, Tarbolton. He was passed and raised in the same Lodge on October1, 1781. He was elected Depute Master of St James's Lodg3e on July 27, 1784, a position he held for 4 years.

A professor of musicology at the University of Edinburgh has noted a Masonic link in Burn's best-know song Auld Lang Syne. At the end of Lodge meetings, especially in the 19th century, the Brothers would form a circle, link crossed hands, and sing a parting ode—this was also common in other fraternal organizations.

Auld Lang Syne was commonly sung. By the 1850s, it as not uncommon to hear the song at college graduations and it was one of the first songs recorded on Berliner's gramophone. It is a song about "ties that bind," and though now synonymous with New Year, it is founded in the world Bro. Burns inhabited—that of Brotherly Love.
